Groupe Ecole Supérieure de Commerce de Troyes was founded in 1992. A new Grande Ecole de Management, member of the « Grande Ecole de Management », was awarded the Trophées des Grandes Ecoles de Management in 2001 and 2005, in recognition of its dynamism and strategic orientation. Today it is one of the top French schools of higher education with 1300 students, a teaching corps of 30 permanent professors and 100 adjunct instructors from the business world.
