Institution's profile

IECS Strasbourg (Institut d'Etudes Commerciales Supérieures), founded in 1919, is a business school that is both a member of the prestigious *Conference des Grandes Ecoles*, and part of the Robert Schuman University. **The IECS Strasbourg offers a three-year business school course of study (diploma of international training in management) and diplomas 2^{ème} et 3^{ème} cycle -2nd & 3rd cycles- (university diplomas, DESS and DEA).** The IECS has been granted an ISO 9001 certification (version 2000 in April 2004).

Located in the Pôle Européen de Gestion et d'Economie (PEGE), in the heart of Strasbourg the European capital, the IECS has more than 1,200 students and over 15 percent are foreign students from more than 20 different countries. The school has organized academic partnerships with INSA (engineering school) and the CCI de Strasbourg et du Bas-Rhin. The PEGE, home also to IAE de Strasbourg and the *Faculté des Sciences Economiques et de Gestion*, offers an exceptional academic environment and brings together over 3,500 students, 150 professors and lecturers, and almost 500 part-time professionals, on a campus of 26,600 square meters.

In the center of PEGE, the IECS has been given extraordinary tools within the strict framework of the grandes écoles, and is part of advanced research work done in economics and management. **The PEGE has a doctoral program that includes three research labs, a trading room and five subject areas for investigation.**

Equipped with powerful equipment that integrates efficiently both new information and communication technologies, IECS has an advanced intranet system, which gives students rapid access to all practical information, numerous tools and online services. Many services can be used by students: self-service computer rooms,

language labs, unlimited internet access, use of the largest management and economics library in Eastern France (situated at PEGE) and many student associations.

Finally, many efforts have been undertaken to provide housing, dining facilities and student associations to create the most comfortable and best student life possible.

Because of its unique location in the heart of Europe, the IECS Strasbourg has developed many partnerships with European universities and elsewhere (**more than 85 exchange agreements in 28 countries**). The school has become a center for excellence in establishing curricula integrated for double European diplômes within the Hermès network, which it created in 1997. The network includes nine universities in seven countries.

Every year IECS welcomes some 150 foreign students and 20 teacher-researchers, underscoring the school's firm commitment to an international outlook.
