



## Ecole Généraliste d'Ingénieurs de Marseille - EGIM

### Institution's profile

Ecole Généraliste d'Ingénieurs de Marseille (EGIM) enrolled its first class in 2003. This school is under the authority of the National Ministry of Education. It brings together the human, scientific and technical dimensions of the founding institutions: ENSSPM, ENSSPICAM and ESM2. The merger with a fourth engineering school in Marseille is in process: the ESIM. The EGIM is associated with the group *Ecoles Centrales* and is in the process of getting approval for eventually being named the *Ecole Centrale de Marseille*. The school's strengths lie in an advanced level scientific education, anchored in the industrial and research worlds, a strong international commitment, and an education in the human and social sciences, to underscore the value of the general engineering profession. The faculty includes 77 full-time professors and 138 part-time staff members. The education program is multidisciplinary, with a non-departmentalised teaching approach in scientific subjects and a cross-disciplinary approach to engineering problems.

**The areas of competence at the EGIM are chemistry, physics, mechanics and modelling.**

The basic training consists of a core scientific curriculum, a core curriculum of general engineering classes, internships and athletic activities.

The EGIM has an outstanding research environment that allows it to provide students with training for and through advanced research. Students can also pursue in their third year, a DEA (Diplôme d'Etudes

Approfondies) or a Master-Recherche. The organization for these degrees is in place. The EGIM also enrolls doctoral candidates who can work on their theses in the school's partner laboratories and its associate doctoral schools.

### Strengths

A tutoring program, specific advising, language classes, lodging and welcome services are available, particularly for foreign students.

The EGIM is in an ideal location in Southern Europe in the Mediterranean region.
