Institution's profile

EISTI is a post-secondary, private, technical school recognized by the government and authorized by the *Commission des Titres d'Ingénieurs* to award the Engineering Master degree. The school has two campuses, one at Cergy-Pontoise, in the Paris area, and another in Southwest France at Pau. The school was established in 1983 and has trained 2,550 engineers in the fields of computer and information sciences.

Students may specialize in their second year:

- Mathematical engineering offers 3 options: financial engineering, industrial informatics, and decision-support systems.
- Computer engineering offers 7 options: management consulting, infomecatronics, engineering of complex systems, engineering of intelligent systems, software engineering, engineering of nomadic information systems, and decisional informatics.

In the third year (semester 5), nine electives are offered (360 hours): software engineering, telecommunications, decision-making in the system of information sciences, applied mathematics and scientific computing, engineering of complex information systems, engineering of intelligence systems, engineering of communication for man and machines, engineering-advice for companies, and financial engineering.

Research

EISTI has 2 research laboratories:

- LASSI, a laboratory for semantic analysis and intelligent systems
- LAPI, a laboratory for research in intelligent processes
- Pau R&D platform

Strengths

The faculty consists largely of full-time professors; a tutor monitors students individually. The school works with other university dormitories and private individuals to help students find suitable lodging. Computer rooms are open 24 hours a day. Loan of a laptop for all the duration of the cycle engineer.

The EISTI campus at Cergy is located about 45 minutes from Paris, on a university campus with 20,000 students. The school has a cafeteria and is located five minutes from a university restaurant. The EISTI campus at Pau in southwest France is a town with about 9,000 students.
