PROFILE

ESIGELEC Rouen, founded in 1901 and a member of the Conférence des Grandes Ecoles, enrolls more than 1,300 students and annually confers 330 engineering degrees. The teaching team consists of 50 permanent professors and a guest faculty of more than 200 drawn from academia and professional life. Backed by the Rouen chamber of commerce and industry, ESIGELEC's highly internationalized curriculum is based on training through projects relevant to industry.

Major fields of study

ESIGELEC Rouen trains engineers in the fields of Informatics networks, computer science, information and communication technologies, electronics, embedded systems, electrical engineering for transport systems, consulting, automation, robotics, mecatronics, and financial engineering. To be added soon: biomedicine, energy, sustainable development.

Non-French-speaking students may elect to spend a semester or full academic year in a program of linguistic and academic preparation before beginning postsecondary study, or before the fourth year, enabling them to meet the challenges of ESIGELEC's curriculum. Depending on the matriculating student's academic background, ESIGELEC offers curricula ranging from 2 to 6 years leading to the engineering degree.

Mastères in Science programs taught in English admit international students at the bac+4 level. The programs in Business Information Systems (offered jointly with the Rouen Business School) and Management of Electronics Embedded Systems require 18 months of study.

Research

ESIGELEC houses the Institut de Recherche en Systèmes Electroniques Embarqués (IRSEEM) which was founded jointly with some 40 companies in the fields of automobiles, aeronautics, electronics, and telecommunications. IRSEEM hosts about 40 doctoral candidates, 75% from outside France.

Strengths

Various procedures reception exist for our non-French-speaking foreign students. The students are met upon arrival at the Paris airport and accompanied to their new quarters which have been reserved by the school and are in Rouen's student housing complex. ESIGELEC's staff helps new international students international office to comply with initial regulatory and administrative requirements, including obtaining a residence permit. School also attaches to accompaniment for the search for training courses.

Location

ESIGELEC Rouen is located in Rouen's south side, just one hour from Paris. A metro line connects the school with the Rouen rail station. Rouen is a beautiful, historic city that boasts many monuments and buildings dating back to the Middle Ages. Economically, the Rouen region is rich in industry—notably in the automotive, aeronautic, electronic, and telecom sectors. The tunnel under the English Channel provides easy access to the United Kingdom.
