### Major fields of study

Construction and public works; chemistry; mechanical design; energy systems; electrical and automated systems; computer science and information technologies; medical and health-related engineering; business organization and management; international textile technologies, innovation, and management; construction, land use, and architecture, banking, finance, and insurance (beginning fall 2008).

### Research

The laboratory of electrotechnics and power electrotechnics, known as L2EP, is a joint responsibility of HEI, the University of Lille 1, ECL, and ENSAM.

HEI maintains five research clusters: chemistry, energy, engineering and the life sciences, materials and structures, and systems and processes.

In the last year of the engineering curriculum, students may elect to pursue a parallel research master.

Students may pursue a doctorate while enrolled at the school.

### Strengths

General professional training combining instruction in science, technology, and management. The curriculum includes a variety of internships, a rich array of student organizations, a humanistic approach, and a mandatory period abroad. Two student residence halls. A campus of 1,700 students. Sixty international partnerships.
