● Institution's profile

Founded in 1875, the Institut Catholique de Paris is a comprehensive university system composed of academic faculties, institutes, schools of management and engineering, and 28 research centers. This diversity of organizational units and disciplines, bound together by a web of links within the Institut Catholique de Paris, favors cross-disciplinary innovation and collaboration in both teaching and research. The main campus is in the historic center of academic Paris, bordering the Luxembourg Gardens and Saint-Germain-des-Prés. Students learn in buildings dating from the 17th to 19th centuries. History and knowledge mingle harmoniously in comfortable work spaces featuring up-to-date equipment. Every year, the institute welcomes 3,500 students who come from 100 countries to study French at the Institute of French Language and Culture or for a variety of other courses. International students enjoy personal attention and full access to the institute's services and facilities.
