Among the very best of France's Grandes Ecoles, the *Écoles Centrales* bring together on their campuses the three mutually reinforcing activities of teaching, research, and business consulting. Founded by manufacturers in 1829 to train engineers for future employment with their firms, the Ecoles Centrales have never deviated from their symbiosis with the economic world.

Located in Lille, Lyon, Marseille, Nantes, and Paris—and affiliated since 1990 and 2005 for Marseille, the 5 *Écoles Centrales* are a major force in French education and research. A permanent faculty of 650, plus 260 more research scientists, train 2,100 engineers and 200 doctoral candidates each year. The schools' alumni network numbers 20,000 active graduates.

The research facilities of the *Écoles Centrales*, renowned in France and abroad, maintain close ties with industry. Exploiting those centers of excellence, the *Écoles Centrales* offer graduate engineering programs at the master's level as well as doctorates.

Valued by firms in every economic sector, the general engineering program of the *Écoles Centrales* is distinguished by its strict selectivity and by the quality of teaching. All students emerge with a solid base of scientific knowledge underpinning the engineering disciplines—and with rigorous management training.
