



# Université Michel de Montaigne Bordeaux 3

## PROFILE

The Université Michel de Montaigne-Bordeaux 3 is an ancient institution whose roots date back to the fifteenth century.

Four Bordeaux universities were founded in 1970. The Université de Bordeaux 3 was named for Montaigne in 1990. It enrolls about 15,200 students, has a faculty of 643, and employs a staff of 360.

Training at the Université Michel de Montaigne Bordeaux 3 is offered through:

- 11 teaching and research faculties
- 1 Institut EGID Bordeaux 3
- 1 university institute of technology (IUT Michel de Montaigne)
- 4 departments, that include: a department for the study of French as a foreign language (DEFLE), a distance-learning department (EAD), and a continuing education department
