PROFILE

The Université Montesquieu - Bordeaux IV is the successor of the faculty of law and economics founded in the 15th century. With 14,000 students, it represents an ensemble of 400 researchers and instructors and a non-academic staff of 300. The university grants about 4,900 degrees a year on its campuses in Bordeaux, Périgueux, and Agen.

Major fields of study

The Université Montesquieu - Bordeaux IV offers programs in the areas of Law, Political science, Economics, and Management business and public administration. It is organized into departments of law, economics, management, and social and economic administration, as well as an institute of business administration and two university institutes of technology, one in Bordeaux and the other in Périgueux. The Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Bordeaux is officially affiliated with the university.

Research

The Université Montesquieu has three doctoral programs (**in law; political science; and economics, management, and demography**), 57 Masters' specializations level (research and professional master). Researchers' individual initiatives are organized into 12 accredited research units by the ministry; many are affiliated with large research organizations such as the CNRS and the Fondation Nationale des Sciences Politiques.

Strengths

The Montesquieu Digital Cluster supports teaching through serves a variety of programs in information technology and communications (ITC) and languages. The digital platform consists of 93 computers running popular office productivity applications, as well as resources for teaching and research.

The digital work space offers students a suite of digital services accessible via a navigation tool that can be used by anyone with an Internet connection. The suite provides access to communications services, to a virtual office, to administrative files, and to library resources useful for study and research.

The Centre régional interuniversitaire de formation en langues (CRIFEL) employs new technology for foreign language instruction (German, English, Spanish, French as a foreign language, Italian). A resource and activity center for language teachers, it has an Internet facility equipped with 6 workstations.
