



## Institut d'Études Politiques de Toulouse

### ● Institution's profile

The Institut d'Études Politiques de Toulouse was founded more than 60 years ago to train public- and private-sector executives. A public post-secondary institution, the IEP de Toulouse is one of nine such institutions throughout France. (The others are in Aix-en-Provence, Bordeaux, Grenoble, Lille, Lyon, Paris, Rennes, and Strasbourg.) It enrolls some 2,000 students in its various programs. More than a hundred professors and instructors teach and conduct research.

**IEP grants several degrees that are of interest to international students. IEP's master's level diploma can be earned in five years of multidisciplinary study** (political science, law, economics, history and society, modern languages). International students who wish to spend one academic year exploring the curriculum may earn the Certificat d'Études Politiques.

IEP also offers **about fifteen Masters in Political Science** in international relations, journalism, security, and public policy and prepares students for civil service examinations (ENA exam and category A exam).

#### Research

The degree programs are housed in IEP's three research centers: the Morris Janowitz Center for Military and Security Studies, the Center for Police Studies (CERP), and the Laboratory of Social and Political Studies (LASPP).

#### Strengths

IEP has long emphasized international cooperation. Through numerous agreements with foreign universities and other partners (Europe, Africa, the Americas, Asia), students in IEP's five-year pro-

gram spend two semesters studying or interning abroad. Reciprocally, IEP welcomes some 250 international students; the majority of whom are enrolled in the one-year Certificat d'Études Politiques program, which begins with a short internship. The emphasis on comparative studies at IEP is another dimension of its international orientation. IEP invites foreign faculty to share teaching duties with the permanent faculty.

#### Location

With 400,000 inhabitants, Toulouse is France's fourth-largest city and the largest in the southwest of France. In addition to being a center of France's aeronautics and space industry, Toulouse has the country's second-largest concentration of post-secondary institutions, with three universities and numerous grandes écoles and engineering schools. IEP is conveniently located in the center of Toulouse near the social sciences university.
