### PROFILE

The Université Paul Verlaine – Metz, founded in 1970, is a multidisciplinary university offering a wide range of degree programmes in most of the major fields of learning. Its main campus, one of the most pleasant in France, is located in the centre of Metz. It has nearly 16,000 students, 15 % of whom come from nearly 100 different countries.

The Université Paul Verlaine – Metz is composed of six faculties (UFRs), three polytechnics (IUTs) and a Franco-German institute (ISFATES). It also hosts 29 high-level research labs, 6 of which, associated with the France's National Research Centre (CNRS), have acquired international renown.

Numerous services are offered to students on the university's seven sites in order to provide them with the learning resources and technologies necessary for their studies, including a large number of libraries, state-of-the-art computer labs and language labs, high-quality cultural activities, theater, a dynamic sports programme and a Student Centre. Major efforts have also been made in the areas of housing, food services and the promotion of student associations in order to offer students the best possible material conditions.

Completely integrated into local and regional life, the university collaborates closely with other institutions of higher learning in Metz as well as the universities of the neighbouring city of Nancy. Through its exceptional geographical location in the heart of Europe, the Université Paul Verlaine – Metz has continuously developed cross-border relationships with its neighbours in Belgium, Germany and Luxembourg. It has notably become a centre of excellence in the development of Franco-German programmes, including numerous bilateral agreements, the establishment of teaching and research networks, student and faculty exchanges and integrated curricula with double diplomas.

This cross-border experience carries over more broadly to the university's international relations with many countries in Europe, Africa, the Americas and Asia. Thus, the Université Paul Verlaine – Metz is involved in more than 100 co-operation agreements with over 35 different countries: the presence of ever-growing number of foreign students and researchers is the mark of the university's policy of international involvement.
