PROFILE

Founded in 1970, the Université Montpellier II is a scientific and technological university with 12,000 students, 12 percent of whom are international. It has 1,600 research professors and researchers and 638 support personnel. Located on a main campus in the midst of pine and olive trees barely 7 km from the Mediterranean, the Université Montpellier II is composed of 7 elements: 3 technical institutes (IUT), one in Montpellier, in Nîmes and in Béziers; one Science faculty with 10 teaching departments; one Business Administration Institute (IAE) and one Engineering school (Polytech' Montpellier, see separate entry), a IUFM. The university's international dimension is integrated into its training and research activities.

Major fields of study

Administration, Management, Business (IUT, IAE), Agronomy, Food Engineering, Biology, Chemistry, Environment and Planning, Civil and Industrial Engineering, Computer Science, Electronics, Business Information Technology, Telecommunications, Mathematics, Physics, Health, Earth and Universe Sciences, Education (IUFM).

Research

The Montpellier campus has 8 doctoral programmes. Equipped with a doctoral research division, the Université Montpellier II trains its students by and for research, an approach which is backed up by the quaoity research activities of the 54 joint research units located on the campus, most of which are linked to the main French research bodies, including the National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS), CIRAD, National Institute of Health and Medical Research (INSERM), National Institute for Agricultural Research (INRA), Development Research Institute (IRA) and Atomic Energy Commission (CEA). The Maison des Sciences de l'Eau and the Institut Européen des Membranes de Montpellier are internationally recognised centres of excellence, Education (IUFM).

Strengths

Centralised services for new foreign students in collaboration with the Pôle Universitaire Européen de Montpellier et de Languedoc-Roussillon; many athletic and cultural activities on campus.
