PROFILE

The Université d'Orléans, a public, multi-disciplinary university, includes four sites in the Centre region: Bourges, Chartres, Indre (Châteauroux/Issoudun), Orléans. It hosts more than 15,000 students under the supervision of 950 research professors. Reconstituted in 1961, the Université d'Orléans has renewed its ties with a university past dating back to 1306. It celebrated its 700th birthday in October 2006.

Major fields of study

The Université d'Orléans offers a wide variety of degree programs integrated into the European Higher Education System (Licence, Masters, Doctorate) and leading to labour-market entry and/or the pursuit of a career in research : generalist and professional licences, research and professional masters, polytechnic and engineering diplomas and doctorates.

Academic programs:

In addition to providing French courses for foreigners (semester-long, short courses à la carte, summer classes), the university has set up specific degree programs for foreign students:

- Master LAME Languages, Businesses and Management' in English

Special services for foreigners:

- International students and scholars receive guidance and support from the PUCVL mobility center.
- Exchange students are welcomed individually by the International Relations Services.
- A one-week orientation program is provided for foreign students in order to facilitate their stay.
- Free loan of a laptop computer provided by the Regional Council of the Centre region.
- The e-campus digital work environment provides digital access to books and journals, Wifi access, computer and internet certification, Visio conferences, and more.
- Services for handicapped students (logistical, educational and technical assistance)
- Many cultural and sports activities.
- The Université d'Orléans has a high-level athletics department. Orléans is an internationally recognised judo centre.
