## PROFILE

Founded in 1970, Paris Est Créteil Val de Marne is a multidisciplinary university with seven faculties and six institutes spread over ten sites in the Val-de-Marne and Seine-et-Marne administrative departments.

It hosts 32,000 students, 17 percent of whom are international (about 112 different countries). There are 3,477 faculty members, including 1,300 research professors; 2,000 external lecturers, 770 administrative and technical staff members are responsible for directing and administering the university.
