● Institution's profile

Founded in 1970, Université Paris III took the name Sorbonne Nouvelle in 1971 in recognition of its roots in the historic Latin Quarter and its mission of innovation in teaching and research.

Today Paris III has an enrollment of 17,883 students (including 5,100 from abroad), a faculty of 630 teachers and researchers and an administrative and library staff of 451.

Major fields of study

Paris III offers national diploma programs and university diplomas in the following disciplines:

- Performing arts (film and media, theater)
- Information, communication, and cultural mediation
- Linguistics and the teaching of language (including French as a foreign language)
- Languages: foreign languages and cultures (German, English, Spanish, Portuguese, Italian, Romanian, Arabic), applied foreign languages
- Letters (French literature, comparative literature)
- Humanities and social sciences (European studies, Latin American studies)

Paris III also offers continuing education and online courses.

Adhering to a policy of scientific integrity, Paris III has a reputation for research quality that attracts scholars from around the world. (46 percent of the doctoral candidates at Paris III are from outside France.) Paris III has 6 doctoral programs and 37 research units, 150 thesis and 18 post-thesis have been defended in 2005.53 colloquia were organized, 44 of which were international in scope.

Strengths

The university's faculty of French as a foreign language welcomes international students seeking to learn French, improve their existing skills, or work toward a degree in teaching French as a foreign language. The university's institute of general and applied linguistics and phonetics carries out language-related research.

The university's film and theater programs are the largest in France; each enrolls more than 1,300 students.
