Founded in 1872, Sciences Po is an institution of higher education and research internationally renowned for the quality of its curriculum and for its innovative approach to teaching. In addition to degree programs, Sciences Po boasts prominent programs in continuing education, research, and publishing.

Sciences Po aims to train future leaders in business, public administration, international institutions, research nongovernmental organizations.

Programs are open to foreign students: undergraduate programs with 6 regional centers specialized in a particular region of the world, professional masters, doctoral study, and a MPA program taught in English in cooperation with the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE), Columbia University.

### Location

Sciences Po is located in one of the most famous districts of Paris. Since the 17th century, Saint Germain des Prés has been the nexus of the city's literary and artistic life.

Sciences Po's campus is steps away from the centers of political decision making in France, with the National Assembly and the Ministerial district close by. Paris is centrally located in Europe, just 135 minutes from London and 80 minutes from Brussels by train, and 90 minutes by air from Barcelona, Rome, and Berlin.
