PROFILE

The Université de Technologie de Compiègne (UTC) is a public institution that combines the strengths of a university with those of a freestanding school of engineering. It is a member of a three-institution network with the Université de Technologie de Belfort-Montbéliard and the Université de Technologie de Troyes. UTC's mission is technology—education, research, and transfer. It trains engineers, conferring the diplôme d'ingénieur, research master's, professional master's, and doctoral degrees. Established in 1972, UTC embraces a dynamic policy of internationalization that includes special programs for international students.

Major fields of study

The curriculum is organized into six major fields:

- Mechanical engineering
- Mechanical systems engineering
- Computer engineering
- Biological engineering
- Industrial process engineering
- Urban systems engineering

Semester structure, transferable credit, two 6-month internships, international student programs, programs responsive to the job market and employer demand.

Research

UTC's structured research policy, a matrix of research themes and research units, allows it to play a vital role at the regional, national, and international levels while providing a solid base for its teaching mission.

Academic services:

Intensive month-long course in French before every semester (August and February), regular courses in French during the year, special science courses for international students, individualized tutorials, guidance in finding and making the most of internships with firms.

Other services:

Visits to industrial and historical sites; cultural and athletic program; student clubs; peer mentoring.

UTC is an integral part of the city of Compiègne, a community of 60,000 inhabitants that is rich in history. Surrounded by a forest of 14,000 hectares, Compiègne is just 45 minutes by train from Paris and 40 minutes by car to Roissy airport.
