ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Degree or level required**
 - Master degree from a European space higher education institution with honours (assez-bien minimum) AND ranking among the top 50% of the class
 - In any other case, acceptance is decided by the academic council of the Doctoral program
- **Languages proficiency**

Given that thesis report must be written either in French or in English, the academic council of the DP can request oral interview, in order to evaluate level of the candidate in one of the two languages.

• Admission procedure

To benefit from Ministry fellowships:

- Applications must be filed during the 3d week of June after having contacted the thesis supervisor offering the project (list validated in April and published on the website of the DP)
- Selection of candidates for oral interview on the basis of academic criteria
- Oral interviews during the first two weeks of July.

For candidates who do not benefit from a Ministry allowance, registration can take place anytime:

- File has to be validated (see above : European Master degree with honours (AB) and ranking in the top-half, or equivalence granted by the academic council of the DP)
- Adaptation of the candidate's profile to the proposed thesis subject.
- A proof of sustained financial support must be provided
