SCIENTIFIC INTEREST

- Doctoral theses prepared at the EDOCIF reflect the tutoring capabilities of Dauphine in the field of applied economics, particularly in the following areas: financial economics, industry and energy economics, international and development economics, health and social protection economics.
- Beyond the diversity of subjects, the common denominator of the research carried out at EDOCIF is economy of organisations, meant in its broadest sense, according to the Dauphine's concept, where the department of "Master Science of Organisations" (MSO) regroups master degree programs in economics, management, law etc.
- EDOCIF doctoral students mostly study the structure and institutional insertion of merchant or non-merchant organisations, including financial ones, placed within a competitive and international environment, with the scope of aid to public or private decision.
- Besides, because of its thematic orientations, EDOCIF encourages most doctoral students to carry out empirical work that demands mastering of quantitative methods (statistics, econometrics).
